2. Allegation of Facts.

2.1 By the orders set out below, the Corporation Commission established the land described in the caption hereof as one 640-acre drilling and spacing unit ("the Unit") for the following named common sources of supply ("the Spaced Formations"):

2.2 Applicant has drilled or proposes to drill a well on the Unit to a depth sufficient to test the Spaced Formations and said well will be the permitted unit well for the Unit.


2.3 The parties named as respondents in paragraph 1 may be the owners of a right to drill into and produce from the Spaced Formations underlying the Unit. Applicant exercised due diligence to locate each respondent and a bona fide effort was made to reach an agreement with each such respondent as to how the Unit would be developed.

2.4 In order to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights and to avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, the Commission should require said respondents to pool and develop their lands or interests in the Unit as a unit.

3. Legal Authority. The relief sought by this application is authorized by 52 O.S. Section 87.1(e).

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


