COMES NOW the Applicant, Continental Resources, Inc., and shows the Honorable Corporation Commission the following:

1. PARTIES:

1.1 Applicant is: Continental Resources, Inc.

Applicant is the owner of oil and gas leasehold interests in the lands described in the caption hereof.

1.2 Respondents are set out on the Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. ALLEGATION OF FACTS:

2.1 By Order No. 97146, 580072 and an Order to be entered in Cause CD No. 201203312, this Commission formed 640-acre drilling and spacing units in Section 34-8N-6W and 15-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma for the Caney, Sycamore, Woodford and Hunton common sources of supply.

2.2. The Woodford common source of supply in the lands covered hereby is a shale formation. The Caney and Sycamore common sources of supply in the lands covered hereby are located immediately above the Woodford common source of supply and the Hunton common source of supply in the lands covered hereby is located immediately below the Woodford common source of supply. In said Section 34-8N-6W, the top of the Caney common source of supply is at an approximate depth of 11,965 feet, the top of the Sycamore common source of supply is at an

approximate depth of 12,140 feet, the top of the Woodford common source of supply is at an approximate depth of 10,290 feet, the top of the Hunton common source of supply is at an approximate depth of 12,408 feet. In Section 27-8N-6W, the top of the Caney is at an approximate depth of 11,700 feet, the top of the Sycamore is at an approximate depth of 11,870 feet, the top of the Woodford common source of supply is at an approximate depth of 12,020 feet, the top of the Hunton common source of supply is at an approximate depth of 12,133 feet. The Caney, Sycamore and Hunton separate common sources of supply may be inadvertently encountered in the drilling of the lateral of a horizontal well in the lands involved herein in the Woodford common source of supply when such well drills out of or exits such shale formation. The Caney, Sycamore and Hunton separate common sources of supply are Associated Common Sources of Supply in regard to the Woodford common source of supply. The Shale Reservoir involved herein covers and includes all three of the separate common sources of supply named above.

2.3 Applicant, as operator, is proposing to drill a multiunit horizontal well in the lands involved herein in the Shale Reservoir covered hereby, with a portion of the completion interval of such multiunit horizontal well to be located in one or more of the 640-acre drilling and spacing units formed for the separate common sources of supply involved herein in said Section 34 and with a portion of such completion interval to be located in one or more of the 640-acre drilling and spacing units formed for the separate common sources of supply involved herein in said Section 27. Applicant is proposing to drill the multiunit horizontal well involved herein from a surface location being not closer than 150 feet from the south line and not closer than 330 feet from the east line of Section 34-8N-6W to subsurface locations of such well's entry into and such well's exit and potential exit from each of the Caney, Sycamore, Woodford and Hunton separate common sources of supply being as follows:

not closer than 0 feet from the south line and 330 feet from the east line of said Section 34-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma,

and with the first perforation in said Section 34 in the horizontal portion or lateral of the borehole of such multiunit horizontal well being as follows:

not closer than 150 feet from the south line and 330 feet from the east line of said Section 34-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma,

and with the last perforation in said Section 34 in the horizontal portion or lateral of the borehole of such well being as follows:

not closer than 0 feet from the north line and 330 feet from the east line of said Section 34-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma,

and with the subsurface location of the exit from said Section 34 of the horizontal portion or lateral of the borehole of such multiunit horizontal well being as follows:

not closer than 0 feet from the north line and not closer than 330 feet from the east line of said Section 34-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma (with the horizontal portion or lateral of the borehole of such multiunit horizontal well at this point entering said Section 27-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma),

and with the subsurface location of the entry into said Section 27 of the horizontal portion or lateral of the borehole of such multiunit horizontal well being as follows:

not closer than 0 feet from the south line and not closer than 330 feet from the east line of said Section 27-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma

and with the first perforation in said Section 27 in the horizontal portion or lateral in the borehole of such multiunit horizontal well being as follows:

not closer than 0 feet from the south line and not closer than 330 feet from the east line of said Section 27-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma

and with the last perforation in said Section 27 in the horizontal portion or lateral of the borehole of such multiunit horizontal well being as follows:

not closer than 150 feet from the north line and not closer than 330 feet from the east line of said Section 27-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma

and with the terminus or end point of the horizontal portion or lateral of the borehole of such multiunit horizontal well in said Section 27 being as follows:

not closer than 0 feet from the north line and not closer than 330 feet from the east line of said Section 27-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma

and with a "tolerance distance" for the above-described subsurface locations, horizontal portion or lateral and completion interval of such multiunit horizontal well in said Sections 34 and 27 being as follows:

a distance of not more than 80 feet in a westerly direction and not more 80 feet in an easterly direction from any such subsurface location, from any point on or along such horizontal portion or lateral and from any point on or along such completion interval

and to complete such multiunit horizontal well in and to produce hydrocarbons from the separate common sources of supply involved herein. Applicant intends to run casing in the horizontal portion or lateral of the borehole of the multiunit horizontal well involved herein and to cement such casing so as to cover and isolate the first and last perforations in such horizontal portion or lateral. Applicant is proposing to drill the multiunit horizontal well involved herein to a total measured depth of approximately 22,807 feet and is proposing to have a completion interval in such multiunit horizontal well of approximately 9,761 feet. The proposed multiunit horizontal well involved herein is necessary in order to prevent waste and to protect the correlative rights of the owners of oil and gas rights in the units involved herein.

2.4 The Commission should allocate to each of the affected units covered hereby the reasonable drilling, completion and production costs associated with the multiunit horizontal well involved herein and the commingled production and proceeds from the completion interval of such multiunit horizontal well. Based upon the information now available, Applicant is proposing that the allocation factor for each of the affected units involved herein should be determined by dividing the length of the completion interval of the multiunit horizontal well involved herein located in each such affected unit by the entire length of the completion interval of such multiunit horizontal well. In the event the lateral of the multiunit horizontal well involved herein stays within the productive portion of the Woodford common source of supply throughout the drilling of such lateral, then Applicant anticipates that approximately 47.27% of the completion interval of such multiunit horizontal well will be located in said Section 34 and approximately 52.73% of such completion interval will be located in said Section 27, with the cost of and the production and proceeds from such multiunit horizontal well to be allocated between the affected units involved herein based on such percentages. The actual allocation of such costs, production and proceeds may vary depending upon the results of the multiunit horizontal well involved herein.

2.5 Attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof is a map showing the location of each currently existing well in each of the affected units covered hereby and the approximate anticipated location of the proposed multiunit horizontal well involved herein. Within the area in and around the lands covered hereby, there have been very few horizontal wells drilled within the Woodford common source of supply and therefore, the nature and quality, including the potential productivity, of such common source of supply is not known. The results of the multiunit horizontal well involved herein will provide significant information concerning the nature and quality of the Woodford common source of supply in the lands covered hereby which will be used to determine whether any other horizontal wells are necessary within the lands involved herein for the full and efficient development and operation of the Shale Reservoir covered hereby within the affected units involved herein. If the multiunit horizontal well involved herein is successfully drilled and if the results of such multiunit horizontal well are significant and if the price of natural gas is favorable, Applicant may potentially drill additional multiunit horizontal wells in the affected units covered hereby if such additional wells are approved by the Commission upon the filing of a proper application therefor at a future date.

2.6 In order to prevent waste, to protect correlative rights and to aid in the full and efficient development of each of the affected units covered hereby, the Commission should approve the multiunit horizontal well involved herein, including establishing the applicable allocation factor for allocating the cost of and the production and proceeds from such multiunit horizontal well to each of the affected units covered hereby.

3. LEGAL AUTHORITY: The relief sought by this application is authorized by House Bill 1909, to be codified as 52 O.S. §87.6 et seq., and OAC 165:5-7-62 and OAC 165:10-3-28.

4. RELIEF SOUGHT: Applicant requests the Corporation Commission of Oklahoma to enter an order, to be effective as of the date of the execution thereof or as of a date prior thereto, as follows:

- (i) Approving a multiunit horizontal well in the 640-acre drilling and spacing units formed for the Caney, Sycamore, Woodford and Hunton separate common sources of supply in Section 34-8N-6W and Section 27-8N-6W, Grady County, Oklahoma, so as to allow such multiunit horizontal well to be drilled as described in paragraph 2.3, above, and to be completed in and to produce hydrocarbons from the above-named separate common sources of supply, and establishing of a proper allocation factor for allocating the cost of and the production and proceeds from such multiunit horizontal well to each of the affected units covered hereby; and
- (ii) Granting such other and further relief as may be proper based upon the evidence presented at the hearing herein.
