from the Oklahoma Universal Service Fund (OUSF) as amended herein.

I. PARTIES:

Applicant, South Central Telephone Association, Inc., 101 South Main, P.O. Drawer B,
Medicine Lodge, KS 67104 is a telephone company subject to the jurisdiction of the Oklahoma
Corporation Commission providing telecommunications services to customers pursuant to its lawful
authority within the State of Oklahoma.

2. ALLEGATION OF FACTS:

Since the filing of the Application in the cause, the Applicant desires to amend its
Application to accurately reflect the primary OUSF being requested. The original filing reflected
estimated federal USF losses for 2012 and 2013, provided by NECA, in spreadsheets marked as
confidential. By the date of the original filing, portions of the FCC's order were implemented and
others were still being modified. The amended filing reflects final lost federal USF revenue from
FCC and USAC sources. Those sources have been provided to staff for verification and are
publically available. The revised Attachment "A" reflects these revisions. Except as amended
herein, the Applicant reaffirms each and every allegation contained in the Application.

3. JURISDICTION:



*The reduction in revenues became effective January 1, 2012 for Safety Net Additive and July 1, 2012 for the per line cap, Inter-carrier compensation, and the Quantile Regression Analysis with additional reductions beginning January 1, 2013 with additional reductions thereafter. The \$178,386 represents the lost revenues for the six months July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012. The lump sum requested is for the revenue lost from July 2012 through October 31, 2012 in the amount of \$118,924 with a monthly recurring amount of \$29,731.
