#### I. PARTIES:

By the date of the original filing, portions of the FCC's order were implemented and others were still being modified. The amended filing reflects final lost federal USF revenue from FCC and USAC sources. Those sources have been provided to staff for verification and are publically available. The revised Attachment "A" reflects these revisions. Except as amended herein, the Applicant reaffirms each and every allegation contained in the Application.

The lump sum requested is for the revenue lost from July 2012 through October 31, 2012 in the amount of \$118,924 with a monthly recurring amount of \$29,731.
