COMES NOW Applicant and alleges and states as follows:

1. Applicant has filed in this cause its request that this Commission create a 640-acre horizontal drilling and spacing unit by: (a) vacating Order No. 107705 insofar as it pertains to the Chester, Mississippi Lime, and Hunton common sources of supply underlying Section 28, Township 10 North, Range 7 West, Grady County, Oklahoma; and, (b) extending Order No. 664890 to include within its purview the Mississippian, Woodford, and Hunton common sources of supply underlying Section 28, Township 10 North, Range 7 West, Grady County, Oklahoma, with the unit well for said 640-acre horizontal unit to be located from its point of entry and along any point of its lateral, not less than 660 feet from said unit boundary for the Mississippian and Hunton common sources of supply, and not less than 165 feet from the north and south unit boundary and not less than 330 feet from the east and west unit boundary for the Woodford common source of supply.

2. Because of contractual commitments and rig availability, it is necessary for the Applicant to commence operations to drill, test, complete and produce the proposed well prior to the date on which this cause is set for hearing.






