COMES NOW the Applicant, Devon Energy Production Company, L.P., and shows the Honorable Corporation Commission the following:

1. PARTIES:

1.1 Applicant is: Devon Energy Production Company, L.P.

Devon Energy Center 333 W. Sheridan Ave. Oklahoma City, OK 73102

Applicant is the owner of the right to drill a horizontal well to the common sources of supply named below underlying the lands described in the caption hereof.

1.2 There are no Respondents to this Application.

2. ALLEGATION OF FACTS:

2.1 That heretofore by an Order to be entered in Cause CD No. 2013(1), this Commission designated Section 19-21N-1E, Noble County, Oklahoma, as a 640-acre horizontal drilling and spacing unit for the production of hydrocarbons from the Mississippian, Woodford, Misener, Sylvan, Viola and Simpson common sources of supply, and designated the unit well to be drilled no closer than 660 feet from the unit boundary for all common sources except the Woodford which is to be drilled no closer than 330 feet to the unit boundary.

2.2 Applicant proposes to drill a horizontal well for the purpose of testing the Mississippian, Woodford, Misener, Sylvan, Viola and Simpson common sources of supply which horizontal well would be located:

1st perforation: no closer than 150 feet from the south line and no closer than 330 feet from the east line of Section 19-21N-1E, Noble County, Oklahoma

last perforation: no closer than 150 feet from the north line and no closer than 330 feet from the east line of Section 19-21N-1E, Noble County, Oklahoma

The entire length of the lateral will be cemented such that the perforations will be isolated from the beginning and end point of the lateral in order to protect the correlative rights of the offset units.

- 2.3 The location of Applicant's proposed horizontal well will not comply with the orders of the Commission and an exception must be granted so that Applicant may drill a horizontal well at the proposed location.
- 2.4 In order to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, Applicant desires an exception to the prescribed unit well location for the common sources of supply named above so that said horizontal well may be drilled by Applicant or some other party:

1st perforation: no closer than 150 feet from the south line and no closer than 330 feet from the east line of Section 19-21N-1E, Noble County, Oklahoma

last perforation: no closer than 150 feet from the north line and no closer than 330 feet from the east line of Section 19-21N-1E, Noble County, Oklahoma

The entire length of the lateral will be cemented such that the perforations will be isolated from the beginning and end point of the lateral in order to protect the correlative rights of the offset units.

- 3. **LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Title 52 O.S. 1971, §87.1.
- 4. RELIEF SOUGHT: The Commission should issue an order granting Applicant, or some other party designated at the time of hearing, an exception to the well location prescribed for the above-named common sources of supply so that said horizontal well may be located at the proposed location as set out above, and further order and authorize said horizontal well to produce a full allowable from said common sources of supply or an allowable as established by the Commission at the time of the hearing.
