APPLICATION

1. Parties: Applicant is Husky Ventures, Inc., 204 N. Robinson, Suite 1800, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73102. The attorney for Applicant is Karl F. Applicant is the owner of the right to drill a well into and produce hydrocarbons from the hereinafter named common sources of supply. The name and address of each party being named as a respondent to this Application is shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. Allegation of Facts:

2.1.a. By Order No. 147635, the Oklahoma Corporation Commission established 160-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil and gas from the Wapanucka, Hunton, Viola, Upper McLish and Basal McLish common sources of supply underlying the SE/4 of Section 24. By the Order to issue in Cause CD No. 201401596, the Oklahoma Corporation Commission will establish 160-acre drilling and spacing units for production from the Spiro, Cromwell, Mayes-Sycamore, Woodford, Bromide, Upper Oil Creek, Basal Oil Creek and Arbuckle common sources of supply underlying the SE/4 of Section 24.

2.1.b. Applicant proposes to drill horizontal well(s) to develop each unit in each common sources of supply and respondents and Applicant have not agreed to pool their interests so as to develop each unit and each common source of supply as a unit. Due diligence has been exercised to locate respondents and a bona fide effort was made to reach an agreement with respondents as to the unit development.

2.3 To protect correlative rights, obtain the greatest ultimate recovery of oil and gas and prevent the various types of waste, the Commission should issue an order pooling the interests and adjudicating the rights and equities of oil and gas owners in the aforementioned common source of supply underlying the captioned premises.
