COMES NOW Applicant and shows the Honorable Corporation Commission as follows:

1. Parties: The Applicant is Gastar Exploration Inc., 1331 Lamar, Suite 650, Houston, TX 77010. The name and address of each party being made a respondent to this Application is as shown on the Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. If any named natural person is deceased, then the known or unknown heirs, executors, administrators, trustees, devisees and assigns immediate and remote, of such decedent are made respondents to this Application. If any named respondent is a corporation which does not continue to have legal existence, then the known or unknown successors, trustees or assigns, if any, of such entity are made respondents to this Application.

2. Allegation of Facts:

a. Applicant has conducted a diligent and meaningful search of the local county assessor's records, county treasurer's records, county deed records regarding the property involved for return addresses on recorded instruments, county probate records and city and county telephone directories and other sources of such information to locate the whereabouts and mailing address of each respondent, or the identify, whereabouts and mailing address of respondent's heirs, executors, administrators, trustees, successors, devisees or assigns, if any.

b. Applicant alleges that the lands in the caption hereof overlie the actual or prospective common sources of supply named below; that Applicant owns oil and gas interests in the area covered by this Application which entitle Applicant to drill for and produce oil and gas from the lands covered by the Application; that the protection of correlative rights and the prevention of waste require that proper drilling and spacing units and well locations be established therefore as horizontal well units, with anticipated hydrocarbon classification and depths as follows:

c. That a single 640-acre horizontal well drilling and spacing unit should be established for the Mississippian and Woodford common sources of supply underlying Section 2, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Kingfisher County, Oklahoma, as described below.

d. The Mississippi Lime common source of supply is currently spaced on an 80-acre basis by Order No. 45607, as redenominated by Order No. 62761, underlying all of Section 2, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Kingfisher County, Oklahoma.

The Chester common source of supply is currently spaced on an 80-acre basis by Order No. 215668, underlying the E/2 SE/4 of Section 2, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Kingfisher County, Oklahoma. There are no wells producing from any of the common sources of supply sought to be spaced herein.

e. By Order No. 633939, dated December 9, 2014, this Commission established a 640-acre horizontal drilling and spacing unit for the Mississippian and Woodford common sources of supply underlying Section 3, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Kingfisher County, Oklahoma, and Order No. 633939 should be extended to include within its purview the Mississippian and Woodford common sources of supply underlying Section 2, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Kingfisher County, Oklahoma.

f. That the permitted well in the drilling and spacing unit requested herein is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain the portion of the common sources of supply (reservoir) covered by such drilling and spacing unit, there being no existing well within the drilling and spacing unit which can effectively and efficiently drain the portion of the common sources of supply (reservoir) covered by such drilling and spacing unit.

3. Legal Authority: Title 52, Section 87.1, O.S..

4. Relief Sought: Applicant requests that the Commission enter an Order granting the following relief:

a) extending Order No. 633939 to include within its purview the Mississippian and Woodford common sources of supply underlying Section 2, Township 18 North, Range 5 West, Kingfisher County, Oklahoma,

with the unit to consist of said 640-acre tract, and with the permitted well to be located, from its point of entry and along any point of its lateral, not less than 330 feet from the east and west unit boundary and not less than 165 feet from the north and south unit boundary for the Woodford common source of supply, and not less than 660 feet from said unit boundary for the Mississippian common source of supply.

5. Relationship to Non-Horizontal Units: Pursuant to Oklahoma Corporation Commission Rule 165:10-3-28(e)(4) and 165:5-7-6(g) the Order to enter in this cause shall exist concurrently with the existing non-horizontal drilling and spacing units described above.

6. Applicant further requests that the Order to be entered in this cause possibly be made effective as of the day of the hearing, or on some other date prior to the date of signing.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that, after notice and hearing as required by law, the drilling and spacing units as requested by Applicant, with appropriate well locations and exceptions thereto, be ordered.
