MOTION FOR TEMPORARY ADMISSION, FOR ADMISSION UPON FILING OF CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE, AND FOR WAIVER OF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING TO OUT-OF-STATE ATTORNEYS

The United States Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies (DOD/FEA), by and through the undersigned counsel, moves for an order granting temporary admission to Mr. Matthew Dunne to practice in the above-styled cause pursuant to 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(2). This motion is supported by the attached Out-of-State Attorney Registration Form, certificates and proof of good standing, and a proposed order granting the motion. This motion is further supported by prior precedent, specifically Order No. 646381 in Cause No. PUD 201500208.

Mr. Dunne has submitted by email and is submitting by overnight courier an Out-of-State Attorney Registration Form with required attachments to the Oklahoma Bar Association (OBA), a copy of which is attached to this motion. Mr. Dunne is licensed to practice as an attorney in New York and the District of Columbia. He is a member in good standing in both jurisdictions. He does not have any disciplinary history in either jurisdiction. In accordance with 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(4) and OBA guidance, Mr. Dunne has requested a waiver of the \$350 registration fee. Upon receipt of the Certificate of Compliance, Mr. Dunne will file it with the Commission.

The Applicants have presented compelling evidence of intrinsic fraud utilized by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company to obtain certain orders and judgments of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission, to include Order No. 341630. DOD/FEA was

affirmatively injured through the aforementioned criminal activity. To date, such injury has yet to be remedied. In the event of a refund of excess revenues by Southwestern Bell and/or its successor(s), DOD/FEA should receive its proportionate share of the recovery.

As a General Attorney with the Regulatory Law Office of the U.S. Army Legal Services Agency, Mr. Dunne represents the consumer interests of DOD/FEA (to include the U.S. Army and the U.S. Air Force) in telecommunication-related proceedings before Federal and state regulatory bodies. The DOD/FEA attorneys named in the Application – John C. Degnan, Lt. Col., USAF; Juan J. Godinez, Capt., USAF; Toribio A. Garcia, TSgt., USAF; and Thomas A. Jernigan, Esq. – do not participate in telecommunication-related proceedings before Federal and state regulatory bodies. Accordingly, failure to grant temporary admission to Mr. Dunne will render DOD/FEA unable to meaningfully participate in this proceeding and cause severe prejudice to the financial and other interests of DOD/FEA.

In the interest of administrative efficiency and in anticipation of receipt of the Certificate of Compliance, DOD/FEA further moves for Mr. Dunne to be admitted to practice in the above-styled cause (on a non-temporary basis) upon the filing of the Certificate of Compliance, in accordance with 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(C).

DOD/FEA also moves for the waiver of all of the requirements in 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(5), including but not limited to:

- the requirement to associate with an Oklahoma attorney;
- the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney enter an appearance;

- the requirement to allow service upon the associated Oklahoma attorney;
- the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney sign all pleadings, briefs, and other documents; and
- the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney be present at all hearings or other events in which personal presence of counsel is required.

The policy objectives underlying these requirements is not applicable to the Federal Government. The Regulatory Law Office of the U.S. Army Legal Services Agency, which is based at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, has delegated authority from the U.S. General Services Administration to represent DOD/FEA in this proceeding. The Regulatory Law Office does not employ any attorneys licensed in Oklahoma, and it cannot further delegate this authority to attorneys located or licensed in Oklahoma.

**ORDER ADMITTING TO PRACTICE AND WAIVING CERTAIN
REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING TO OUT-OF-STATE ATTORNEYS**

The Corporation Commission (“Commission”) of the State of Oklahoma, being regularly in session and the undersigned Commissioners present and participating, there comes on for consideration and action the Motion For Temporary Admission, For Admission Upon Filing Of Certificate Of Compliance, And For Waiver Of Certain Requirements Pertaining To Out-Of-State Attorneys filed herein by the U.S. Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies (“DOD/FEA”) on September 1, 2016 by mail. The Motion related to Mr. Matthew Dunne, a member of the State Bar of New York and the District of Columbia Bar.

In the Motion, DOD/FEA moved for temporary admission for Mr. Matthew Dunne to practice in the above-styled cause pursuant to 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(2). DOD/FEA further moved for Mr. Dunne to be admitted to practice upon submission of the Certificate of Compliance, which was filed with the Commission on September 25, 2015 (by fax, with hard copy by mail) pursuant to 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(C). In addition, DOD/FEA moved for a waiver of all of the requirements in 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(5), including but not limited to: the requirement to associate with an Oklahoma attorney; the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney enter an appearance; the requirement to allow service upon the associated Oklahoma attorney; the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney sign all pleadings, briefs, and other documents; and the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney be present at all hearings or other events in which personal presence of counsel is required.

As supplemented by DOD/FEA, the Motion was supported by a signed application, Certificates of Good Standing from the State Bar of New York and District of Columbia Bar, and the Oklahoma Bar Association’s Certificate of Compliance pursuant to 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II.

DOD/FEA filed its Motion on September 1, 2015. The Motion was set and heard on September 8, 2015. There being no objection, the Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) recommended that the Motion be granted.

There being no oral exception taken to the recommendation of the ALJ, such recommendation becomes the order of the Commission upon the signature of the majority of the Commission.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

THE COMMISSION FINDS that it has jurisdiction over this Motion pursuant to Article IX, § 18 of the Oklahoma Constitution and 17 O.S. §§ 152 and 153.

THE COMMISSION FURTHER FINDS that DOD/FEA's Motion For Temporary Admission, For Admission Upon Filing Of Certificate Of Compliance, And For Waiver Of Certain Requirements Pertaining To Out-Of-State Attorneys should be granted.

THE COMMISSION FURTHER FINDS that DOD/FEA's Motion For Temporary Admission, For Admission Upon Filing Of Certificate Of Compliance, And For Waiver Of Certain Requirements Pertaining To Out-Of-State Attorneys (as supplemented by DOD/FEA on September 25, 2015) complies with the requirements of 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS that the Motion For Temporary Admission, For Admission Upon Filing Of Certificate Of Compliance, And For Waiver Of Certain Requirements Pertaining To Out-Of-State Attorneys be granted and the same is hereby ordered in accordance with the findings herein. Mr. Dunne is hereby admitted to practice in Cause No. PUD 201500208 and the requirements in 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(5) are hereby waived.

THIS ORDER SHALL BE EFFECTIVE immediately.

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ASSOCIATE COUNSEL, FOR TEMPORARY
ADMISSION, FOR ADMISSION UPON FILING OF CERTIFICATE OF
COMPLIANCE, AND FOR WAIVER OF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING
TO OUT-OF-STATE ATTORNEYS**

The Corporation Commission ("Commission") of the State of Oklahoma, being regularly
in session and the undersigned Commissioners present and participating, there comes on for

consideration and action the Motion To Associate Counsel, For Temporary Admission, For Admission Upon Filing Of Certificate Of Compliance, And For Waiver Of Certain Requirements Pertaining To Out-Of-State Attorneys (“Motion”) filed herein by the U.S. Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies (“DOD/FEA”) on September 10, 2015. The Motion related to Mr. Matthew Dunne, a member of the State Bar of New York and the District of Columbia Bar.

In the Motion, DOD/FEA moved for temporary admission for Mr. Matthew Dunne to practice in the above-styled cause pursuant to 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(2). DOD/FEA further moved for Mr. Dunne to be admitted to practice upon submission of the Certificate of Compliance, which was filed with the Commission on September 25, 2015, pursuant to 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(C). In addition, DOD/FEA moved for a waiver of all of the requirements in 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(5), including but not limited to: the requirement to associate with an Oklahoma attorney; the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney enter an appearance; the requirement to allow service upon the associated Oklahoma attorney; the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney sign all pleadings, briefs, and other documents; and the requirement to have the associated Oklahoma attorney be present at all hearings or other events in which personal presence of counsel is required. 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II, Sec. 5(B)(5) further states, with respect to these matters, ... “unless the Oklahoma court or tribunal waives these requirements.”

DOD/FEA filed its Motion on September 10, 2015. The Motion was set and heard on September 17, 2015. There being no objection, the Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) recommended that the Motion be granted with instructions which were complied with, as set forth herein.

As supplemented by DOD/FEA on September 25, 2015, the Motion was supported by a signed application, Certificates of Good Standing from the State Bar of New York and District of Columbia Bar, and the Oklahoma Bar Association’s Certificate of Compliance pursuant to 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II.

There being no oral exception taken to the recommendation of the ALJ, such recommendation becomes the order of the Commission upon the signature of the majority of the Commission.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

THE COMMISSION FINDS that it has jurisdiction over this Motion pursuant to Article IX, § 18 of the Oklahoma Constitution and 17 O.S. §§ 152 and 153.

THE COMMISSION FURTHER FINDS that DOD/FEA’s Motion To Associate Counsel, For Temporary Admission, For Admission Upon Filing Of Certificate Of Compliance, And For Waiver Of Certain Requirements Pertaining To Out-Of-State Attorneys should be granted.

THE COMMISSION FURTHER FINDS that DOD/FEA’s Motion To Associate Counsel, For Temporary Admission, For Admission Upon Filing Of Certificate Of Compliance, And For Waiver Of Certain Requirements Pertaining To Out-Of-State Attorneys (as

supplemented by DOD/FEA on September 25, 2015) complies with the requirements of 5 O.S. Ch. 1, App. 1, Art. II.


ORDER

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS that the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth herein are hereby adopted as the Order of the Commission.

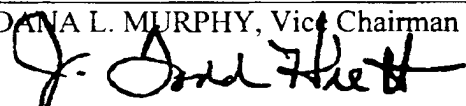

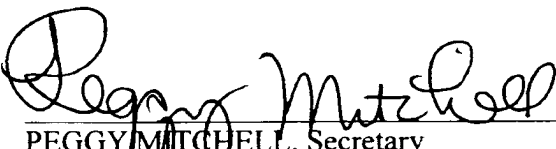

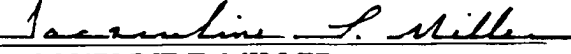
