**ORDER OF THE COMMISSION**

This Cause came on for hearing before David Leavitt, Administrative Law Judge for the Corporation Commission of Oklahoma, on November 29, 2011, in the assigned Administrative Law Judge's courtroom, Jim Thorpe Building, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, for the purpose of hearing, taking testimony and reporting his findings and recommendations to the Commission.

Emily P. Smith, attorney, appeared for Applicants, Chesapeake Operating, Inc. and Chesapeake Exploration, L.L.C.

The Administrative Law Judge heard the Cause and filed his report with the Commission, which report has been considered and the Commission therefore finds as follows:

**FINDINGS**

1. This is an application of Chesapeake Operating, Inc. and Chesapeake Exploration, L.L.C. for an Order vacating Order No. 143480 in its entirety.
2. That the Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter and of the persons interested herein. That notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Commission. At the hearing, Respondent No. 13 was amended to address unknown. The following respondents were shifted to curative: Nos. 1, 5, 10 and 15.
3. On July 25, 1978, the Commission entered Order No. 143480, which order purported to pool the interests and adjudicate rights and equities in the Tonkawa, Lansing-Kansas City, Cherokee, Mississippi, Cottage Grove, Oswego, Chester, Hunton, Viola, Simpson and Arbuckle separate common source of supply under the lands described in the caption hereof (the "Order").
4. The Order was entered in Cause CD No. 54852, filed by Tuthill & Barbee
5. The Massman 2-24 Well was drilled pursuant to Order No. 143480. The well produced for several years and was plugged on April 11, 1983.
6. The oil and gas leasehold interests of the Applicants are impacted and adversely affected by the entry of the Order which constitutes a cloud upon their title, rights and authority to drill for, and produce, oil and gas from the various separate common sources of supply encompassed by the lands described in the caption hereof.

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7. Since the date of entry of Order No. 143480, additional or new data, derived in part from the development or trend of development in the area, has been obtained which constitutes a substantial change in conditions or change in knowledge of conditions existing in connection with the separate common source of supply, such that Order No. 143480 should be vacated in its entirety.

8. That in the interest of securing the greatest ultimate recovery of petroleum hydrocarbons from said separate common sources of supply, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights, this application should be granted.

**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Corporation Commission of Oklahoma as follows:

That Order No. 143480 should be vacated in its entirety.
