Jurisdiction:**

Notice has been given as required and the Commission has jurisdiction of the subject and persons.

Relief Requested:

Applicant requests that eight (8) additional wells be permitted for the unit comprised of Section 35-13N-10W, Canadian County, Oklahoma.

Relief Granted:

The requested relief is granted; the wells will be for the common source of supply described below and underlying the 640-acre unit described above, as an exception to the following order:

Common Source of Supply

Reason for Relief:

A geological and engineering analysis indicates 46.384 BCF of original recoverable gas in place. The existing well will recover 4.6 BCF, leaving 41.784 BCF remaining. It is anticipated that each of the

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requested additional wells will recover 4.6 BCF, leaving sufficient amounts of gas remaining to drill eight additional wells.

Allowable:

If completed as oil wells, they will be assigned a 160-acre allowable. If completed as gas wells, the wells shall be assigned the allowable pursuant to the order entered in Cause CD No. 201301971.

Companion Causes: None.

That the increased density well, in accordance with the foregoing, is necessary to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, and DEVON ENERGY PRODUCTION COMPANY, L.P. should be permitted to drill and produce the well as set out herein, provided that such increased density well must be commenced within one year from the date hereof or this Order shall be of no force and effect, and IT IS SO ORDERED.



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
