
**ORDER DISMISSING CAUSE**

3. At the time of the hearing, the evidence showed that Applicant no longer intends to pursue the requested relief. Therefore, this matter should be dismissed.


**ORDER**

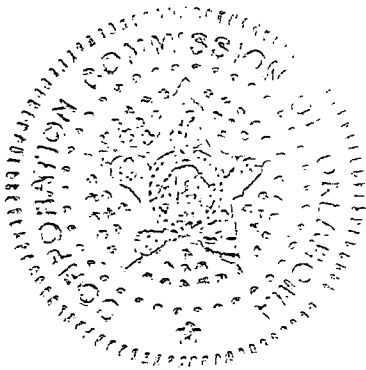




