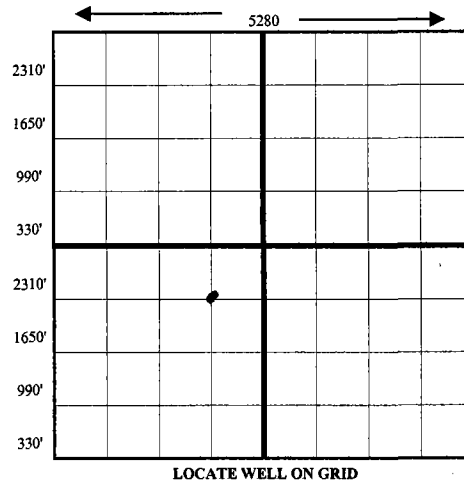

responsible for ^{protecting} and marshal the tangible and intangible assets of the businesses wheresoever situated, real and personal property, including, but not limited to, leasehold rights, equipment, stock on hand, livestock and racehorses.

2. The Receiver shall cause the businesses to be operated ^{per the previous law operating} so as to preserve the ^{said} assets and reasonably enhance the value of the assets. ^{business}

3. The Receiver shall, within 60 days, prepare and submit to the Court and parties, an Inventory of all assets and liabilities of the businesses, indicating an estimate of the fair market value of each asset worth in excess of \$10,000 and a total estimate of value of the assets.

4. The Receiver shall investigate and determine the likely ownership interest of any persons or entities in and to the assets of the businesses, and shall report same to the Court and parties. The Receiver shall investigate and prepare a report of all transactions of the businesses for the previous one year from the date of his appointment to assist the Court in determining what actions have been taken by Plaintiffs since Defendant's exclusion from the businesses.

5. The Receiver is authorized to obtain or maintain all necessary licenses, permits, or applications on behalf of the businesses ^{as may be needed and not already obtained} and may issue subpoenas to obtain documents and conduct discovery as a party to this action.

6. In the event that any of the parties to this action have any assets of the businesses in their possession, or have transferred any assets that were property of the businesses ~~within the past 365 days~~, the parties shall identify those assets and ~~turn them over~~ to the Receiver ^{at the Receiver's discretion}. The Receiver is authorized to file civil actions to recover assets of the businesses ^(report in the ordinary course of business)

7. The parties herein are ordered and directed to cooperate fully with the Receiver and assist the Receiver in the performance of his duties. This assistance shall include turning over information that the Receiver deems necessary, providing codes or passwords required to access computer files or bank information, and advising all persons who owe money to the businesses that the debts should be paid to the Receiver. ~~and business in the ordinary course of business~~

8. The Receiver may ~~sell or dispose of assets, subject to accounting, that have a value less than \$10,000 and may petition the Court for permission to sell or transfer~~ ^{any} assets, ~~that in his opinion should be sold or transferred.~~

9. The Receiver shall report to the Court on a quarterly basis. The Receiver shall petition the court for payment of fees and costs. ~~and may seek assistance from the Court on any matter at any time, and on either to all parties~~ ^{of} ~~the~~

10. The Receiver shall have the rights and obligations imposed by Oklahoma law. The Receiver shall be a party to this action for purposes of all notices and appearances.
